1. When special events are being held (i.e. bands, dances) or when larger crowds are present, a trained door person will check and verify the customer's age. On other nights, the bartender will be required to check and verify the customer's age before serving them. The customer will be required to provide a state-issued picture I.D.
2. Customers who are between ages of 21-26 will be fitted with a dated wristband which cannot be removed without being destroyed. Bartenders and/or waitresses will only serve customers with wristbands on (or those obviously older, i.e. over 26). If the wristband on patron appears questionable, the bartender or waitress will check the person's identification.
3. If a person is purchasing a pitcher of beer or more than one beverage, other members of the party must be identified and checked for wristband or carded. Employees will also periodically check tables with pitchers of beer to determine if any persons under 21 are drinking.
4. Persons under 21 with beer or alcoholic beverage will be required to leave the premises. Any person 21 or over providing beer or alcoholic beverage to a person under 21 will be required to leave the premises.
5. All persons under the age of 21 will be required to leave the premises by **10:00 P.M.**
