Must be able to pass a pre-employment physical and drug test. A good driving record is mandatory. Non-user of tobacco products. Normal hours of work are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (but can be flexible) for an average of 30 hours per week from May 15<sup>th</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup>. Pay will range from \$10 to \$13 per hour. Applications are available in the Clerk's Office at City Hall, located 611 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Applications are due by Friday, May 3, 2019.

**JOB SUMMARY:**

Under the direct supervision of the City Engineer, the part-time inspector is a non-exempt position under the FLSA. The position is a part-time position. The successful applicant will work an average of 30 hours per week from May 15<sup>th</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup>. The work includes conducting inspections of constructed infrastructure, providing inspections of the excavations in the public right-of-way by utility companies and contractors, and sidewalk inspections. Average pay will be \$10 to \$13 per hour. Regular attendance is required.
