1. Minutes of the October 10, 2017, meeting

The reading of the minutes of the October 10, 2017, meeting, was dispensed with. M/S; Kahler/Bentley to approve the minutes; unanimously approved.

2. On-street parking: 100 block 2nd Avenue South

We have received a request from Gateway Towing, 103-105 2nd Avenue South to eliminate the "No Parking" that is currently in place on the north side of the 100 block of 2nd Avenue South (this is the area directly south of Kelly Oil). Michael Freeman, the owner of Gateway Towing, wants to construct a curb cut at 105 2nd Avenue South, which would eliminate some on-street parking on the south side of 2nd Avenue South.

M/S; Nelson/Bentley to move the eastern most sign to 30 feet west of the Kelly Oil driveway and install a "30 Minute Parking" sign; unanimously approved.

3. On-street parking: 1944 15th Avenue South

We have received a request from B & E Machine, 1944 15th Avenue South, to restrict on-street parking in this area, as semi drivers are having problems backing into businesses for receiving and shipping. One possibility may be to implement no on-street parking between the hours of 7 a.m. to 4-5 This item was tabled from last month's meeting.

M/S; Nelson/Bentley to establish a "No Parking between hours" sign; unanimously approved.
